Home Learning task:

This week our home learning task is linked to our Maths..

Next week we will be recapping how to read the time for o'clock and half past times from year 1. We will then move on to telling the time to the nearest 15 minutes. For their home learning, children need to practise reading: o'clock, half past, quarter PAST and quarter TO times. Children in year 2 do not read digital time and instead need experience reading analogue clocks.

Some of the learning that has taken place this week...

In Maths we have made amounts using different coins and added costs together to find totals. In English we have begun to use adjectives and similes to describe the Dark. In Science we have found out why exercise is good for our bodies. In DT we evaluated our vehicle from last week and in history we shared our research and knowledge on Elon Musk and his different companies.

Next week...

We will focus on telling the time to the nearest 15 minutes in maths. We will begin planning our own story about the Dark in English. In History we will be looking back on all the powerful people we have learned about this term and putting them in chronological order.
