This week our home learning task is linked to our Geography.

We have been learning to name and locate the 7 continents and 5 oceans of our planet.

For their home learning, children could use a map, globe or atlas to name and practise locating the 7 continents and 5 oceans.

Some of the learning that has taken place this week...

In Maths we have completed a maths assessment which was based on the learning we have covered since September, as well as previous year 1 learning. In English we wrote stories for our Big Writes.
