Home Learning task:

This week's home learning task is linked to our Geography. Children will be comparing sea ice coverage from the 1980s to the present to see if climate change is having an impact on the Arctic.

For their home learning, children need to find out what other impacts climate change could be having on our planet.

Some of the learning that has taken place this week...

In Maths we have partitioned 2- and 3-digit numbers in different ways, created number facts and derived further facts from these. In English we have practised identifying the four different sentence types, recapped using conjunctions and identified word types within sentences. In Geography we have learned about the greenhouse effect and how a thicker atmosphere is making our Earth warmer. In Science we have worked in teams to sort and classify animals as reptiles, mammals, amphibians, birds and fish.

Next week...

In English we will be writing a character description of Peter Rabbit. In Maths we will be revisiting 2D and 3D shape. In Geography we will be examining the sea ice coverage from the past and present. In Science we will be classifying animals as carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.
