Our learning

In English we looked at singular and plural. We learned that to pluralise a noun ending in sh, ch, ss, s, x and z you have to add -es onto the word. For most other words, you just add -s. We also did our guided reading.

In Maths we compared numbers using words such as most, greatest, least, fewest and we worked on putting numbers in the correct place on numberlines up to 20.

Next week we will be sequencing and re-telling the story ‘Where the Wild Things Are’ in English and we will be finding 10 more and 10 less than a number in Maths.

Please could you practise writing numerals with your children at home, making sure that they are not reversed. Also, when writing 2-digit numbers, check that when writing, for example, thirteen, they write 13 and not 31.
