Our learning

In English we have made a story map for 'Where the Wild Things Are' and have listened to 2 other fantasy stories- 'Beegu' and 'The Way Back Home' by Oliver Jeffers. Children are doing well with their reading- using their phonics skills but becoming more fluent too. In Maths we worked on finding 10 more and 10 less than 2-digit numbers and some addition word problem too.

Next week we will be planning our own version of 'Where the Wild Things Are' in English and we will be working on addition and subtraction number problems in Maths.
